The Annual Parish Meeting for Kexby was held at 7:30 on 24 May 2017 in the Upton cum Kexby Village Hall

Those present

14 members of the public 6 councillors

Ron Gore opened the meeting and welcomed everyone

The minutes of the meeting held on 18 May 2016 was agreed and signed as a true record

RG gave the chairman report a copy of which is attached.

Questions and queries coming from that report are

That the telephone box has still not been repaired. This issue had also been raised at the 2016 meeting. RG stated that he had been trying to get quotes to do the work that was need but had only got one to date which was £3,000. There was also a suggesting that the box be sold.

The hedge behind the telephone box needed cutting back but this was an issue which the council had no jurisdiction

It was stated that the 106 bus which comes through the village was to stop as the funding had been withdrawn by the WLDC. This would mean that the bus shelter would become redundant. It was pointed out that this was not the case as the school bus would still be using the stop during school term

Parking on Glentworth Road was still a problem as the cars were effectively blocking the pavement. The advice was to ring the Police 101 and request that a PCSO call and speak to the offenders

The Annual meeting was then closed and refreshment served

In the second part of the meeting the clerk outlined the work that she did as a clerk to the council for anyone that maybe interested in taking the position which was becoming vacant

RG then raised the issue of the proposed building on Westgate. There was a lively debate centring around whether there was a need for this. The proposed selling price would be £250,000 to £280,000 well above the amount affordable to the young in the village. The councillors asked that villagers think about what they would like in the village and email RG with their ideas.
